

JULY MISSION PROJECT

It's time for Christmas in July! We want to spread holiday cheer and make a difference by helping make Shoeboxes for children who may not otherwise have a Christmas! Here's how you can help. Each Sunday in July, we will be asking you to bring specific items that we will use to fill the shoeboxes. Please pay attention to the items, because these are the items that UMCOR has asked for. If you do not want to shop, donations are gladly accepted and we will shop for you. Just ensure that you mark your donation as "Shoebox" or "Christmas in July". On July 27th after the 11:00 service, our youth and children will have a Shoebox party to eat and fill the shoeboxes. Laura Willoughby will then take the shoeboxes to UMCOR. Last year, we did an amazing 75 shoeboxes thanks to your generosity. This year we have a goal of 100 shoeboxes! With your help, we know we can make this happen! Bring your items and put them in the basket in the Narthex! Thank you so much for being the hands and feet of Christ for children who may not be able to experience Christmas otherwise!

July 6th: Clothes (ages 2-12 years old-Boys/Girls), flip-flops, underwear, wash cloths

July 13th: Toothbrushes (no toothpaste), large tooth combs, pony tail holders, barrettes, small sewing kits, nail grooming kits, hand mirrors

<u>July 20th:</u> Hot Wheel/Matchbox cars, small dolls, small sport balls, small stuffed animals, YOYO (Duncan brand), jump rope, Play-Doh (must be Play-Doh brand), play jewelry, small hard rubber balls, child development or educational card game

<u>July 27th:</u> Fun pens/pencils, small erasers, colored pencils, pencil sharpeners, small pads of paper, crayons (must be Crayola brand 12-24 pack).
