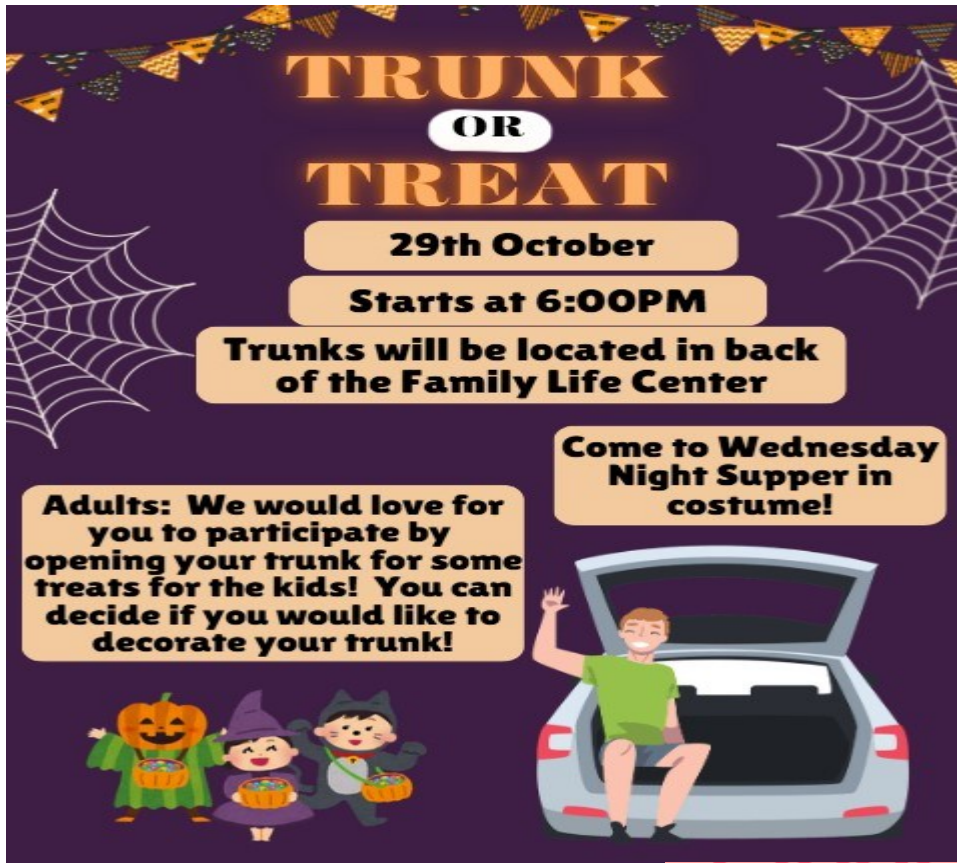

PASTOR'S PANTRY NEWS

We are excited to announce that we are being considered to be a part of the Midwest Food Bank! This will allow us to get free food once a month to stock our pantry! We have an inspection on 10/6 to get approved.

Becky Gaar has also applied for us to receive a grant of \$2500 to help with Pantry costs! We will undergo an inspection for that and should find out next month if the application is approved!

- ♦ In September, we served 112 families for a total of 309 individuals.
- ♦ In August, we served 78 families for a total of 237 individuals.
- ♦ In July, we served 110 families for a total of 321 individuals.

The needs in our community are growing and we are blessed to have an opportunity to be a place where those who are in need can come for assistance. Thank you to all who love and support our Pastor's Pantry. We could not do this without you!
